Level 5- 5- 6 years or Level 8-9

Level 4 - 4- 5 years or Level 6-7

Level 3 - 3- 4 years or Level 4-5

Level 2 - 2- 3 years or Level 2-3

Level 1 - up to 2 – Preparatory or Level 1
